Brett Hamilton is a second generation Afghan Hound breeder born in Melbourne, Australia. His parents Colin and Helen Hamilton of “Kjavu” Kennels in Australia have been breeding top quality Afghan Hounds for four decades.

Together with his parents they have bred/owned & shown well over 100 champions winning over 150 All Breed Best In Shows & multiple times Australia’s #1 dog of the year awards.

As a teenager Brett started his judging career & at just 21 years of age he became one of the youngest judges ever in Australia to be licensed for the entire Hound Group.

In addition to judging in Australia, Brett has judged throughout the USA, Europe and New Zealand. His first assignment in America was in 2009, making him one of the youngest judges in AKC's history to judge a Hound Group.

Brett with his Swedish fiancé Camilla Tell-Collinge (Tells Afghans) have had great success exhibiting Standard Poodles with multiple Best of Breed wins at Crufts & multiple Best in show awards across the world, Australia's top dog all breeds 2013 & 2014. They have also had great success exhibiting their Afghan Hounds & Hungarian Puli as a top 10 Show dog of the year in Sweden 2015 & 2016.

In 2016 under the new Kennel prefix "Hashtag" Brett & Camilla bred their first Standard Poodle litter which has produced a Specialty BIS Winner with Junior Winner & Winner titles already added to his name.

In 2017 Brett was granted permanent residency to live in Sweden & has now had his Australian (ANKC) Judging license transferred over to the Swedish Kennel Club.

Brett is deeply honored to judge at the prestigious Greater Twin Cities Afghan Hound Club 2018.
